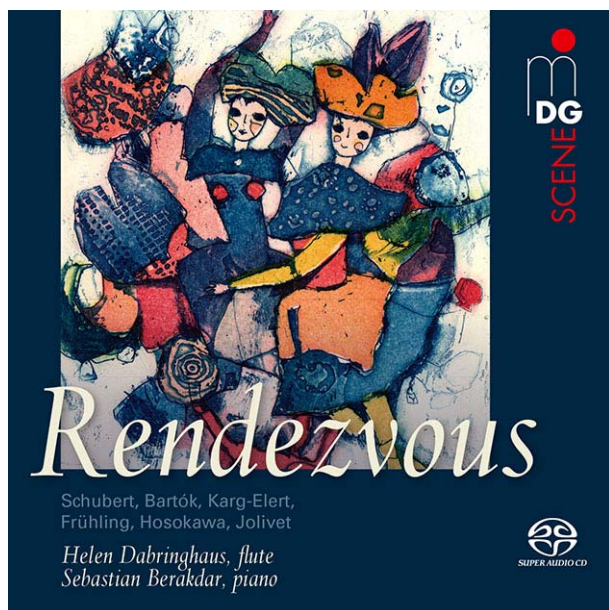

*Rendezvous* is the title **MDG** has given to their new SACD of music for flute and piano performed by Helen Dabringhaus and Sebastian Berakdar. The music covers two centuries beginning with Fantasy for Flute, Op. 55 by Carl Frühling, a composer otherwise forgotten today. Then we have Bartók's Hungarian Suite arranged by the composer's pupil, Paul Arma, and the program continues with other works listed above. Ms. Dabringhaus is a master flutist, given strong accompaniment by Sebastian Berakdar. Excellent sound with a natural concert hall atmosphere.
